(Washington, DC -- June 22, 2010) – C-SPAN, the public affairs network's flagship channel, now is available in over 100 million U.S. cable and satellite households.

C-SPAN was created by America's cable companies in 1979 as a public service and programs three public affairs television networks (C-SPAN, C-SPAN2 and C-SPAN3); C-SPAN Radio, a Washington, D.C. public affairs FM radio station also distributed by XM Satellite Radio; and a video-rich website which hosts the C-SPAN Video Library.
