On C-SPAN's behalf, Penn Schoen Berland (PSB) asked 1,200 American adults to indicate if they were familiar with various historic Supreme Court decisions.

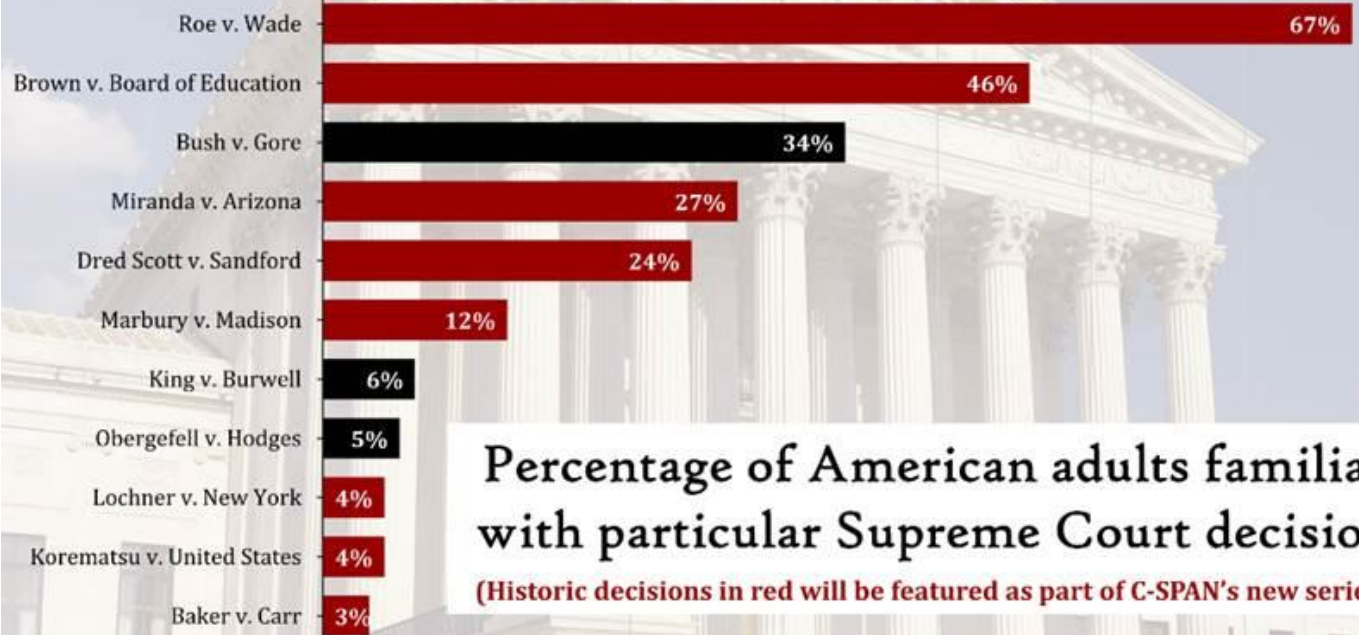

Methodology:

Penn Schoen Berland (PSB) conducted online interviews from July 1-6, 2015 among n=1,201 American adults nationally. The margin of error for this study is +/- 2.83% at the 95% confidence level and larger for subgroups.
