Every weekend: SATURDAY 8 AM ET - MONDAY 8 AM ET

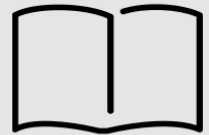
## Book TV Programming

"In Depth" is a live, three-hour Book TV interview with a notable author airing the first Sunday of every month, noon - 3 pm ET on C-SPAN2. The three hours are devoted to the author's body of work. Past guests include William Buckley, Christopher Hitchens, Ann Coulter, Tom Brokaw, Alice Walker, and many others. Each guest takes viewer calls, emails, texts, and tweets.
